The images below show the screenshot of the homepage:

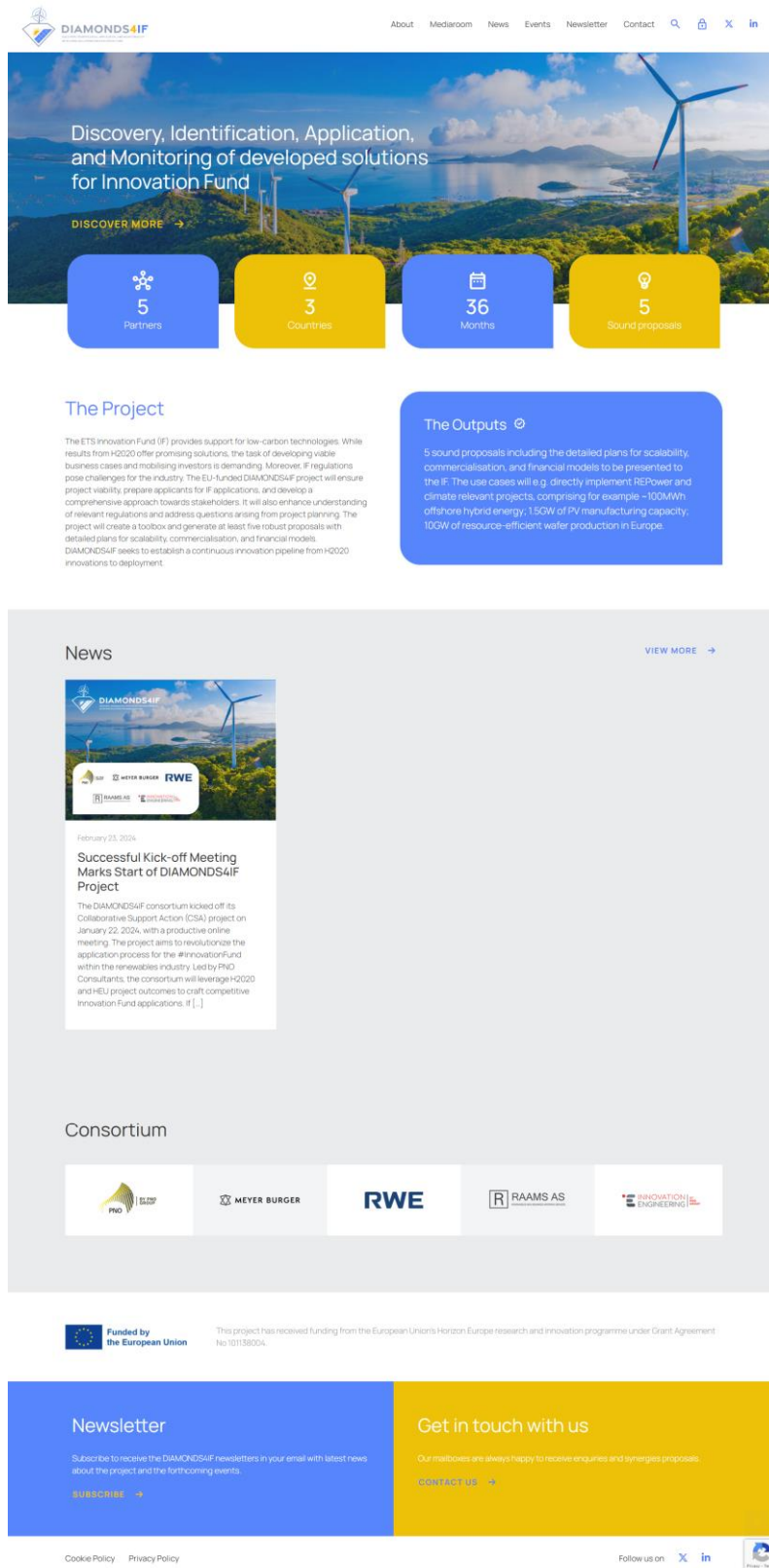


Figure 1. Home page screenshot

2.2 PARTNERS PRIVATE AREA

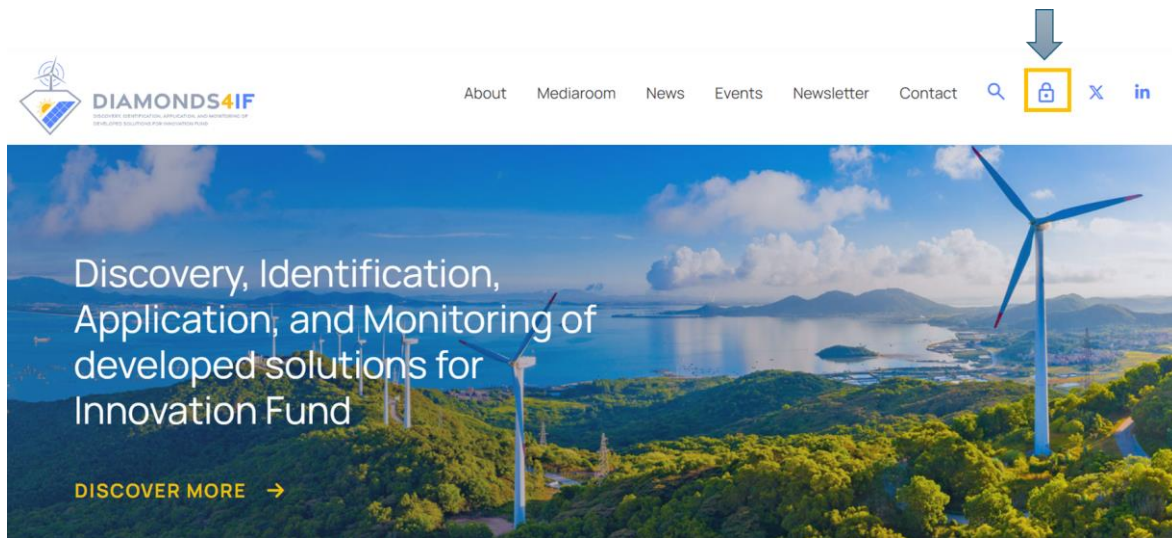


Figure 2. Login area screenshot

 - **Consortium:** the list of the project partners with a brief description of their major activities, the link to their corporate website and the official logo.
- **Mediaroom:** this webpage contains publicly available materials, deliverables, and a dissemination kit available for download.
- **News:** page providing brief news from the project.
- **Events:** page dedicated to publish events organized by the consortium and/or related to the project objectives.

- **Contact:** page containing a standard web-based form to submit feedback or questions to the DIAMONDS4IF consortium.
- **Newsletter:** page providing a registration form that will grants to the registered users to receive a newsletter from the DIAMONDS4IF community.

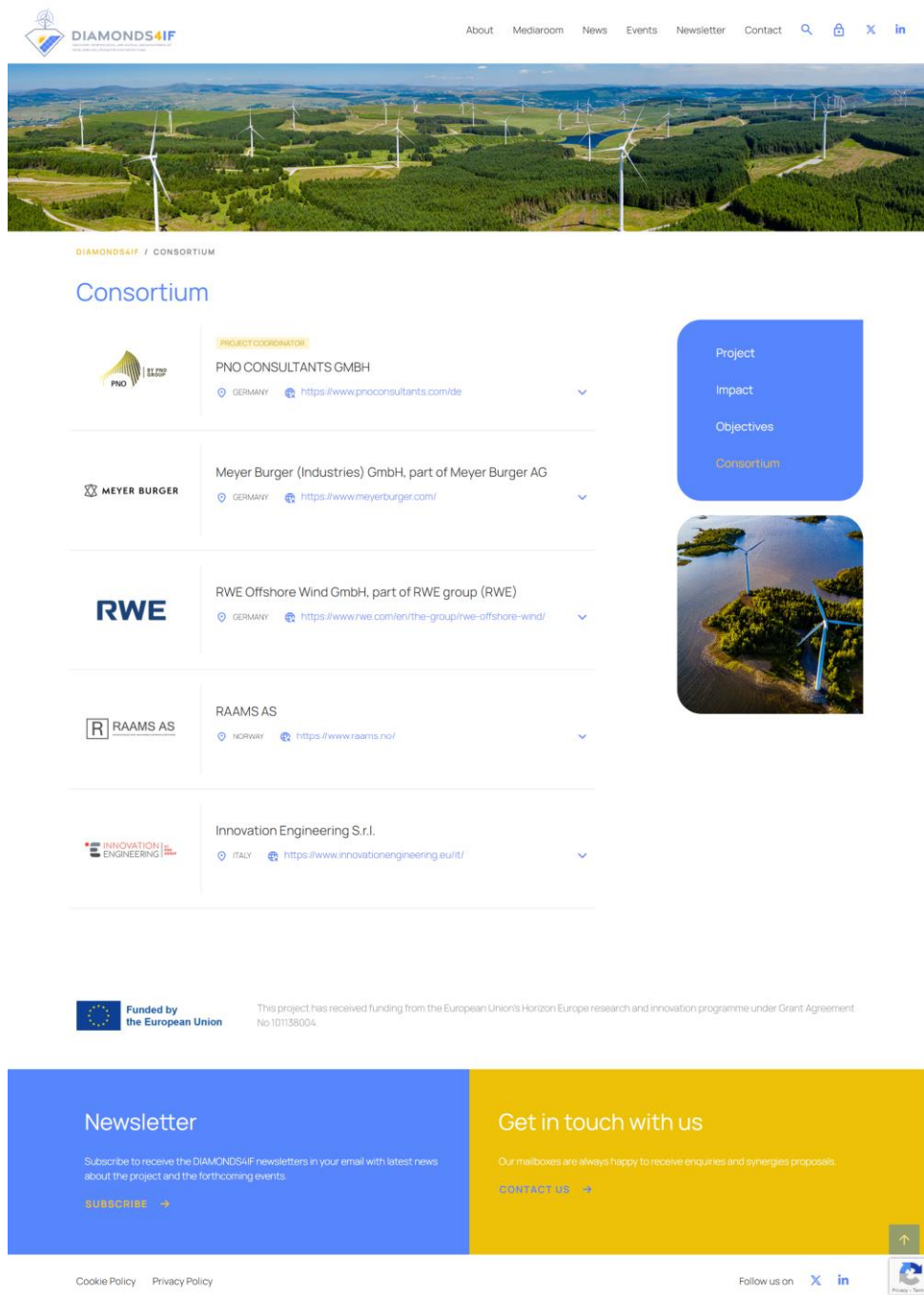


Figure 4. Consortium Section – Screenshot

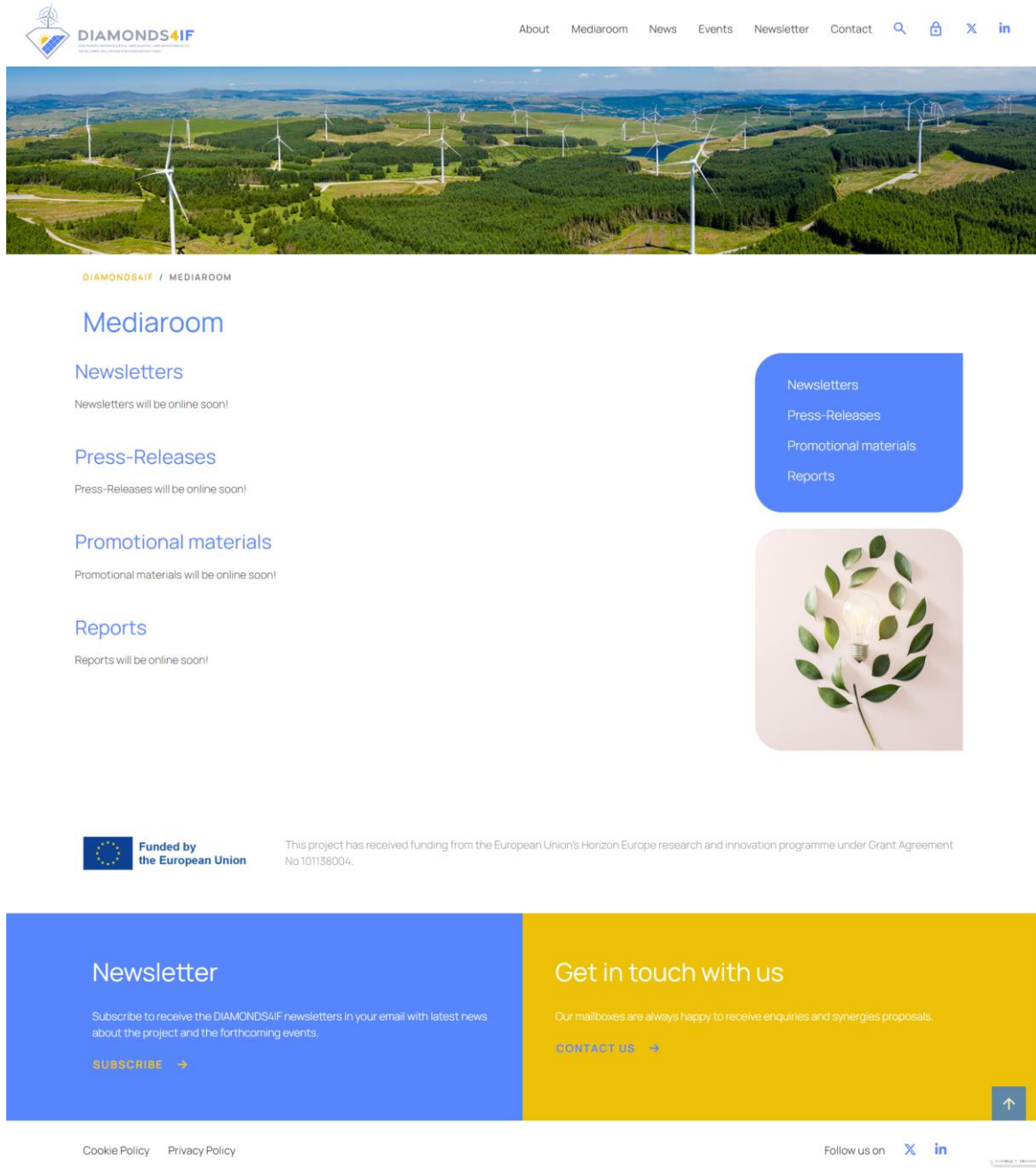


Figure 5. Mediaroom section – screenshot

This section contains useful functions for project management:

- **Documents:** Document Management System that allows the project partners to share documents, deliverables, images, etc.
- **Partners:** list of contacts of the DIAMONDS4IF consortium
- **Calendar/Events:** function to share or schedule events on a calendar grid. All partners are informed by email each time a new event is created.
- **Discussion:** function to create private discussion and forum for the DIAMONDS4IF consortium.
- **Doodles:** function to create and share polls inside the DIAMONDS4IF partners group.
- **Mailing list:** create, manage and update the mailing list for the DIAMONDS4IF consortium.

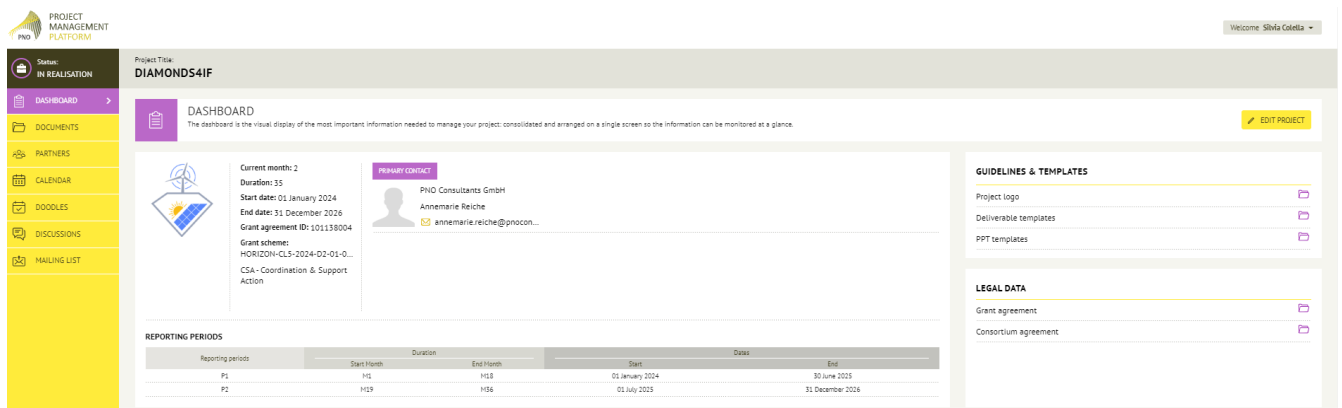


Figure 7. Project Management Platform - screenshot
